Community members that are concerned about speeding motorists can meet with John McEvoy at Chris Peake's home on Monday morning, 8 th Sept, to monitor traffic. Further discussion followed and it was decided to invite John McEvoy to the October meeting. WT suggested that installing more small 30 mph signs along the route would be another deterrent. AN commented that laying pavements was the best option.
