Matters Arising	<b>J McEvoy</b> – to request data from the monitor which recorded traffic movements adjacent to Pant-teg <b>J Pearce</b> – although some cutting back of branches on the overgrown hedge at Deri has been done, the work done is inadequate and unacceptable. Yet again, no work done on the Felin hedge; how to proceed from here on in needs to be discussed.	
Correspondence	<b>Council Tax rise of 4.45%</b> - the Councillors protested about the matter as seemingly, the additional money collected will be paid to unelected Cabinet Members who already receive inflated salaries. Comparisons were made with the immoral wages paid to Directors of the construction company CARILLION that went into liquidation. Other aspects of services that are underfunded were discussed, such as Highways and the perilous state of the roads and the agreement that the route between Banc y Ffordd and Llanpumsaint would be gritted but that has never happened. Clerk to write and complain about the wage increase paid to Chief Executive, Mark James.
